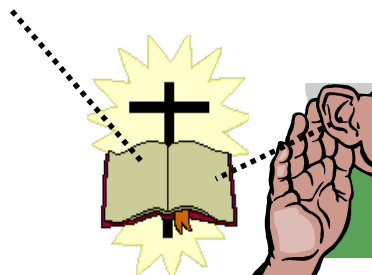


## “THE H.E.A.R SEMINAR”
