THE BIG DAY

The **Big Day** is almost here! For several weeks as a bulletin insert you have been informed regarding THE BIG DAY. The Big Day is tomorrow, May 3, where Seventh-day Adventists all over the Washington Conference are asked to participate in community service and disaster response. January's floods have give us an opportunity

to play a part in disaster response in the Skagit Valley. There are plenty of projects available if volunteers will respond.

The first major project deals with inventory of building materials for Skagit Interfaith Disaster Recovery Organization. Volunteers are needed to inventory materials. People familiar with building materials are desperately needed. We estimate 5-6 people for this project over a 3-4 hour period. Also at this site volunteers are needed to pull nails out of salvage lumber (bring your crowbar and hammer). This project will help SIDRO move forward with their ability to serve.

Depending on how many volunteers respond there is a possible 'mucking out' project. Several homes affected by the floods are still in need of this type of help.

As far as community projects there are several possibilities. They range from painting fences and windows to light yard work.
