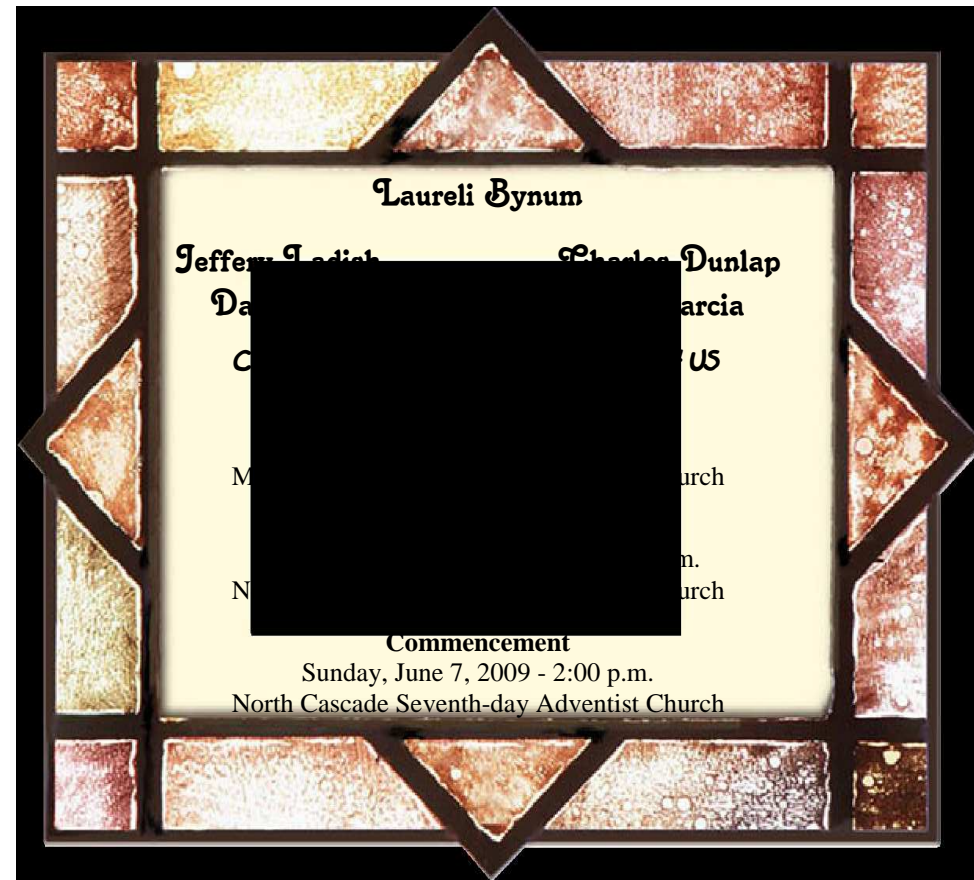
SAS GOLF TOURNAMENT
