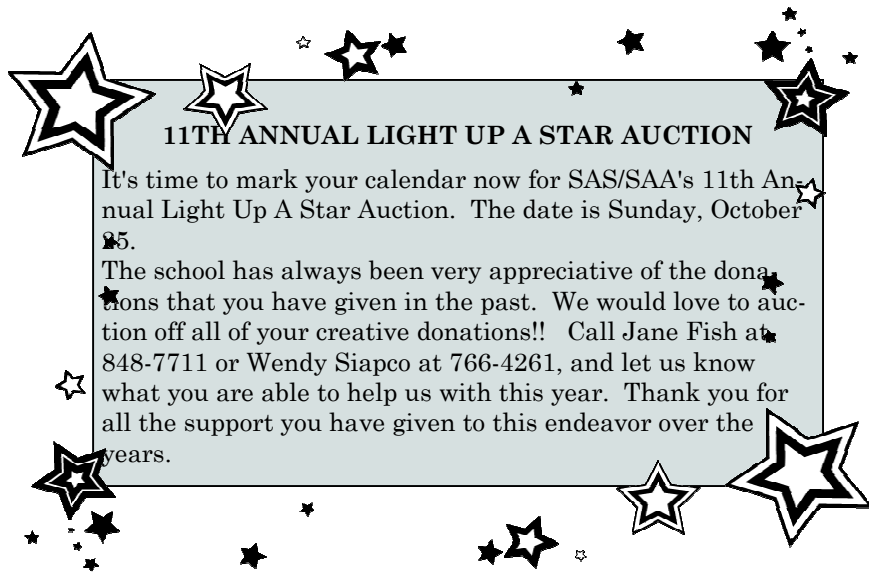
CANNED SOUP / CHILI, OIL, FLOUR, SUGAR
