SABBATH HIKE

July 10 - Baker River

- Difficulty level: 1
- Distance: 0.6 to 2.5 miles each way
- Type of hike: Flat terrain along river & stream with mountain views
- Elevation gain: 150 ft.
- User rating: 8 out of 10
- Pets welcome
- Departing NCSDA after Sabbath School (bring sack lunch). Drive time from NCSDA to Baker River Trailhead: 1 hour. Leaders: Scott & Sheila VonBergen (360)333-2394

Description:

Sharing the first 0.5 miles with the Baker Lake Trail No. 610, enjoy an easy amble through cedar groves, mossy rock gardens, and alongside the pristine river - a preview of what lies ahead. The two trails diverge at a suspension bridge.

Families with small children may prefer to enjoy the suspension bridge as an end destination - there's lots to see and do, and the water beckons as do the sand and

rocks along the picturesque shore. If it's a hot day, plan on little feet getting wet.

For those who would like to cover more ground on an easy hike, continue across the bridge on what becomes Baker Lake Trail.

Please note that if you decide to skip the bridge and continue along the left side of the river on Baker River Trail, no dogs are allowed after 2 miles as this becomes Cascade National Park.

Directions:

Head east on the North Cascades Highway (State Route 20) for 23 miles, turning left (north) onto Baker Lake Road (between mileposts 82 and 83). Continue on Baker Lake Road for 26 miles (it becomes Forest Road 11, and the pavement ends after 23 miles), reaching the road end and trailhead (elev. 750 ft). A NW Forest Pass is required for parking. Privy available.
